Rules & Regulations

1. VOGUE FUSION- Fashion Show

Rules and Regulations

- **One** entry per college.
- It is a team event comprising of 12-18 members.
- Time limit for every team would be 10 minutes (Including setup and the performance both).
- Negative marking if participants exceed the time limit.

Theme for fashion show - is the COLOUR PEACH FUZZ

- The teams can use their creativity to display the colour and its relevance
- Participants are required to bring their own copies of sound tracks in standard audio format and also share the same with the student coordinator 2 days prior.
- Vulgarity and any sensitive content are strongly prohibited. It may lead to cancelling the team from participation.
- Use of props that are improper (fire, alcohol, cigarettes, etc.) is strongly prohibited
- Teams will be judged on Costumes, Relevance to the theme, Walk and Attitude.
- Teams have to bring their own props
- Kindly ensure to bring your college ID Card.

2. SYMPHONY- Duet Singing

Rules and Regulations

- Maximum of two participants are allowed to participate in a team.
- Participants can sing the song of their own choice.
- Pairs of participants can be same gender or opposite gender.
- Participants must bring instrument or instrumental music with their own to perform.
- Time limit of performance is 2-3 minutes.
- Maximum of **Two entries per Institute will be considered** (Based on first come first served basis, and total entries of event)
- Screening will be done on the basis of the number of participants.

3. SUR TAAL- Solo Singing

Rules and Regulations

- Participants will not be allowed to refer to the lyrics while singing.
- Time allotted for each performance is 2-3 minutes.
- The participants **will be judged on the song selection**, **voice quality, clarity, rhythm and their appeal to the audience**.

- Participants should bring their own musical instruments if required in the performance.
- Choice of song is open to the participants but the song should not have any slangs or derogatory language.
- Use of recorded background track is also permitted, but the same has to be submitted to the event coordinator 2 days before the event.
- Obscenity (at the discretion of judges) of any kind is not allowed.

4. KALAKRATI- Rangoli

Rules and Regulations

- It's a theme based Rangoli creation competition based on imaginative concepts. The participants will be required to create Rangoli with different colors and materials showing One selected theme.
- Slots will be marked for each team
- Time Duration: 120 minutes
- Team can comprise of maximum 4 members
- The participants must bring their own materials (dry color, flowers, sand etc.)
- The participants will not be allowed to refer to any printed material etc. for preparing Rangoli.
- The team will be judged on the basis of presentation, creativity, utilizing of space, describing the design to the judges and reflection of theme. **Themes**
 - 1) Abstract Art
 - 2) India Culture and Spirituality
 - 3) Kolam Theme Rangoli

5. NATRAJ- Solo Dance

Rules and regulations

- Each individual is expected to bring his/her good quality soundtracks on a portable device (pen drive) on the day of the event and they should also send the same 2 days before to the student coordinator.
- Time limit for stage performance is limited to a maximum of 3 min.
- There will be negative marking if the time exceeds.
- The track will be stopped after 3 min.
- Vulgarity of any kind (song selection and Costume) will not be tolerated as it may lead to disqualification.
- Maximum of two entries per Institute will be considered (Based on first come first served basis, and total entries of event).
- If required Preliminary qualifying round will be there depending upon the number of participants. Details and schedule will be the core team accordingly.

6. GHUNGROO- Group Dance

Rules and regulations:

- Each Group is expected to bring its own good quality sound tracks in pen drive on the day of event and should also send the same 2 days prior to the coordinators for synchronization.
- Time limit for stage performance is limited to a maximum 6-8 min. If the performer exceeds the time limit, the track will be stopped
- The 8 min includes stage setup time.
- Create the track of 7 min only.
- Members in each Team should have participants 10-18 members.
- Vulgarity of any kind will not be tolerated as it may lead to disqualification.
- Only one entry per institute will be entertained.
- The coordinators will provide no props; participants can carry their own props.
- Green rooms would be given for changing purposes.
- The participants will be judged on the basis of their rhythm, formations, synchronization, expressions, costume & overall performance.

7. MANCHTANTRA- Nukkad Nattak

Theme selection depend upon participant's own choice

Rules and regulations

- The team will comprise of 12-15 members.
- Time allotted for each performance will be 10-15 minutes (Including setup time)
- There will be negative marking if the time exceeds.
- Teams can use music, props, jingles and color codes to create an impact.
- The role-play screening will be judged prior to final round.
- One Team per institute is allowed.
- The theme of the play should be socially relevant.

8. GAMEQUEST- IT Gaming

BGMI: MAPS - (Erangle, Miramar & Sanhok)

Rules & regulations

- Team Event- Squad of 4 will be allowed.
- Squad must be from same Institute.
- Squad need to bring their Institute ID card for verification and Xerox copy of the same will be submitted.
- Physical Presence of the player inside the campus is mandatory during the event.
- Device & amp; Internet will be of the player itself.
- Institute will not be responsible for any issue related to device or Internet breakup.
- The Winner will be on the basis of the Survival.

9. JAM- Just-a-Minute

Rules and regulations:

- 1 individual per team (Individual Competition).
- Registrations would be done on a first come, first serve basis.
- Participants will be divided into groups of 5 each.
- Each group will be given multiple prompts, and each group will be given 1 minute in total to speak on each prompt.
- One member of the group would be selected to speak for the prompt through drawing of chits.
- While a member of the group is speaking, the other members of the group will have to say 'jam' and point out any Repetition, Hesitation or Deviation.

10.SHUTTERBUG-Photography

Rules and regulations:

- This is an individual event (No team)
- Theme should be given on the spot.
- Photograph should be relevant to the theme "PEACH FUZZ".
- Maximum of three photographs can be submitted per student
- Photograph should be captured within the campus and no editing & filters can be used.
- Provide technical details of the image.
- Only DSLR Cameras can be used.
- The event will start from the Inauguration of PULSE and there will be a area demarcated for participants, they should adhere to the same else the participant will be disqualified.

11.TRASH TALES- Best out of Waste

Rules & regulations

- Team shall consist of two members only.
- Participants will be given 2 hours to show their creativity and 1 minute to present the concept to judges.
- The required waste material and stationery like scissor, thread, etc. should be brought by the participants.
- Waste material could be anything like tetra packs, bottles, newspapers, old utensils, jute material or any second-hand items that otherwise would be thrown away.
- The material would be rejected if not found to be a waste product or secondhand item.
- No ready or semi-finished model or matter would be accepted from participant in competition.
- Participants will be judged on Creativity, Utilization of Resources, Artistic composition & design, Eco-friendly rating, Utility of the Product and Overall Presentation

12.GEET GATA CHAL- Antakshari

Rules and regulations

- A team should consist of three members.
- Each participant is required to register through the Registration link.
- Total time of the contest will be 90 min.
- There will be 4 rounds, in case of a tie there shall be a tiebreaker round.
- Repatriation not allowed: Once you have sung a song, you or any other team cannot repeat the same song again.
- Mash-up not allowed: You or any other team are not allowed to sing Mash-ups, every team should sing single song at one go.
- Start from the beginning: All teams have to start any song from the first line or lyrics. You must follow the original song; any modification / own version is prohibited.
- Humming is not allowed: All teams are required to sing with original lyrics, at least first two line of the song that you attempt else no marks will be allotted.
- Play Healthy game: All team are advised to play a healthy game, no team is advised to use any judgmental statement like singing quality, or skill.

13.MASK IT- Face Painting

Rules and regulations

- It is a team event having 2 participants.
- Participants should bring their own colors, brushes etc.
- Time limit is 90 minutes.
- Topic will be given on the spot.
- Participants will be judged on the basis of creativity, innovation, design and utilization of space.
- Decision of the judges will be final and binding.
- No part of the design may be applied to the model's face prior to the starting of the time clock for this competition period.
- Design may not extend down the neck or onto the chest, shoulders or back area of the model.
- Competitors and models may not leave the competition area after the competition has started, but may be excused by one of the competition judges, if needed.

14. PIXEL SYMPHONY- Doodle it!

Rules and regulations

- Individual Entry Event
- **Theme:** Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam having the colour PEACH FUZZ theme of PULSE 2024
- <u>Doodle Dimensions</u>: Create your masterpiece within a 1080 x 1080 pixel canvas.
- Originality is Key: Your submission must be your own unique creation. No plagiarism or copyrighted material allowed.
- Spread Kindness through Pixels: Avoid any derogatory or offensive content that could hurt sentiments or opinions.
- Embrace the Community: Share your progress and insights on the designated online platform.
- > All participants to carry ID card of their institute at all times
- > Once they physically register on campus they will be given a BAND, which they have to wear for 2 days of event.

- > Judges decision will be final and no argument shall be encouraged.
- > Restrict to time lines so no negative marking occurs.
- Any indiscipline activity or non-approved material found on campus the team will be sent back immediately.
- All tracks to be sent 2 days in advance, else no last minute changes will be encouraged.
- > Any inappropriate content entry will be DISQUALIFIED
- > Support the Core and Discipline team for smooth conduct of the mega event.
