
(FASHION WALK - GROUP)

- Negative marking if participants exceed the time limit.
- Participants are required to bring their own copies of sound tracks in standard audio format and also share the same with the student coordinator 2 days prior.
- Vulgarity and any sensitive content are strongly prohibited.
 It may lead to cancelling the team from participation.
- Use of props that are improper (fire, alcohol, cigarettes, etc.) is strongly prohibited.
- Teams will be judged on Costumes, Relevance to the theme,
 Walk and Attitude.
- Teams have to bring their own props
- Kindly ensure to bring your college ID Card and aadhar card
- The team is requried to register with a fee of ₹1000/- for the event.

(GROUP DANCE)

- Vulgarity of any kind will not be tolerated as it may lead to disqualification.
- Only one entry per institute will be entertained.
- The coordinators will not provide props; participants have to carry their own props.
- Green rooms would be given for changing purposes.
- The participants will be judged on the basis of their rhythm, formations, synchronization, expressions, costume & overall performance.
- The team is requried to register with a fee of ₹1000/- for the event.

(SOLO DANCE)

- Each individual is expected to bring his/her good quality soundtracks on a portable device (pen drive) on the day of the event and they should also send the same 2 days before to the student coordinator.
- Time limit for stage performance is limited to a maximum of 3 min.
- There will be negative marking if the time exceeds.
- The track will be stopped after 3 min.
- Vulgarity of any kind (song selection and Costume) will not be tolerated as it may lead to disqualification.
- Maximum of two entries per Institute will be considered (Based on first come first served basis, and total entries of event).
- If required Preliminary qualifying round will be there depending upon the number of participants. Details and schedule will be shared by the event student coordinator accordingly.



(SOLO SINGING)

(SOLO SINGING)

- This is an Individual event. No team participation is allowed.
- Time allotted for each performance is 2-3 minutes.
- Participants will not be allowed to refer to the lyrics while singing.
- The participants will be judges on the song selection, voice quality, clarity, rhythm and their appeal to the audience.
- Participants should bring their own musical instruments if required in the performance.
- Choice of song is open to the participants but the song should not have any slangs or derogatory language.
- Use of recorded background track is also permitted, but the same has to be submitted to the event coordinator 2 days before the event.
- Obscenity (at the discretion of judges) of any kind is not allowed.



(DUET SINGING)

- Time limit of performance is 2-3 minutes.
- Maximum of Two entries per Institute will be considered
 (Based on first come first served basis, and total entries of event)

 Screening will be done on the basis of the number of participants.



(IT GAMING)

- Device & Internet will be of the player itself.

- Participants must bring their own gaming devices (mobile/tablet), headphones, and chargers. No devices will be provided.
- Only pre-registered teams will be allowed to compete;
 on-spot registrations are not permitted.
- No third-party software, cheats, or hacks are allowed. Any violation will result in immediate disqualification.
- Use of triggers, emulators, or additional gaming accessories is strictly prohibited
- The Winner will be selected on the basis of the Survival and kill points.

- All team members must be from the same institute and must provide valid ID proof.
- Performance must be in Hindi, English, or bilingual.
- No use of recorded music or microphones. Only live instruments like dhol, dafli, or manjira are allowed.
- Time allotted for each performance will be 12-15 minutes (Including setup time). Exceeding the time limit will lead to penalties.
- Teams must ensure that their act is socially relevant and appropriate for a general audience.
- Any form of disrespectful behavior towards any religion, caste, nation, or gender is strictly prohibited.
- No vulgarity, obscene gestures, or inappropriate content will be tolerated.
- Use of fire, water, or any hazardous materials is strictly prohibited.
- Teams can use music, props, jingles and color codes to create an impact.
- Any form of disrespectful behavior, offensive language, or misconduct towards the audience, judges, or other participants will result in disqualification
- Team has to Register for ₹1000/- for the event. (Without fees Registration is Cancelled)



(DOODLE IT)




- This is a solo participation event. Team entries will not be accepted.

- Any external images will lead to disqualification.
- No editing, filters, or AI enhancements are allowed. Only raw, unedited photographs will be accepted
- DSLR cameras and Mobile photography is allowed.
- The event will start from the inauguration of PULSE 2025. Participants can begin capturing photographs only after the event has officially started.
- A designated area will be marked for participants. Straying beyond this area will result in immediate disqualification.
- No plagiarism, pre-shot images, or use of stock photos will be tolerated. Strict action will be taken against violators.
- Any disrespectful, offensive, or inappropriate content will lead to immediate disqualification.



(BEST OUT OF WASTE)

- Waste material could be anything like tetra packs, bottles, newspapers, old utensils, jute material or any second-hand items that otherwise would be thrown away.
- Only genuine waste or second-hand items are allowed. Any material that does not qualify as waste will be rejected.
- Pre-made, ready, or semi-finished models will not be accepted.
 Participants must create their designs from scratch during the competition.
- Participants will be judged on Creativity, Utilization of Resources,
 Artistic composition & design, Eco-friendly rating, Utility of the Product and Overall Presentation.



(STAND UP COMEDY)

(STAND UP COMEDY)

- This is an individual event. No team participation is allowed.
- Time Limit: Each participant will get 3-5 minutes to perform. Exceeding the time limit will result in deduction of marks or disqualification.
- All performances must be strictly original. Plagiarized, copied, or pre-existing jokes will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Any disrespectful, offensive, or vulgar content targeting any religion, caste, gender, nationality, or individual will not be tolerated.
- Use of abusive language, explicit content, or inappropriate gestures is strictly prohibited. Violators will be disqualified immediately.
- No political or religious propaganda is allowed in the performances.
- Props, background music, or sound effects are not allowed. Only the performer and their words are permitted.
- Participants must maintain the decorum of the event. Any act of misconduct will lead to immediate expulsion from the competition.
- Judging Criteria: Originality, comic timing, audience engagement, delivery, and overall presentation.
- The Judges' decision will be final and binding. No arguments or objections will be entertained.



(RANGOLI)

- The participants will be required to create Rangoli with different colors and materials showing One selected theme.
- Slots will be marked for each team
- Time Duration: 120 minutes
- Team can comprise of maximum 4 members
- The participants must bring their own materials (dry color, flowers, sand etc.)
- The participants will not be allowed to refer to any printed material etc. for preparing Rangoli.
- The team will be judged on the basis of presentation, creativity, utilizing of space, describing the design to the judges and reflection of theme.



(FACE PAINTING)

Step into the world of Mukhauta 2025, where faces become canvas and colors breathe life into imagination. (FACE PAINTING)

- Each team must consist of two members one as the painter and the other as the model. No individual participation is allowed.
- Theme will be given on the spot. Participants must strictly adhere to the theme.
- Participants must bring their own materials, including paints, brushes, sponges, and other necessary tools. No supplies will be provided.
- Time limit: 1.5 hours for painting, followed by 1 minute for explanation to the judges.
- Only face painting is allowed. Body painting beyond the face is strictly prohibited.
- Use of pre-made stencils, stickers, or any pre-designed elements is not allowed. Everything must be hand-painted during the competition.
- Judging criteria: Creativity, adherence to theme, neatness, color combination, and overall presentation.
- No offensive, disrespectful, or vulgar designs related to any religion, caste, gender, or nation will be tolerated.
- Competitors and models may not leave the competition area after the competition has started, but may be excused by one of the competition judges, if needed.

PULSE 2025 - EVENT GUIDELINES

- All participants must carry their Institute 's ID card at all times during the events.
- Once they physically register on campus they will be given a BAND, which they have to wear for 2 days of event.
- Judge's decision will be final and binding, no argument will be entertained.
- Restrict to time lines so no negative marking occurs.
- Any act of indiscipline or possession of non-approved materials will result in the immediate disqualification and removal of the team from campus.
- All tracks to be sent 2 days in advance, else no last-minute changes will be encouraged.
- Participants must report 30 minutes before their performance slot. Late reporting may result in disqualification.
- The Organizing Committee's decision are final and cannot be challenged.
- The Organizing Committee holds the right to disqualify any participant for misconduct, rule violations, or unfair play.
- All Participants are expected to support the Core and Discipline team for smooth conduct of the mega event.
