## **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR** THE EVENTS:

## 1.Piece to Camera (P2C)

- The duration of your piece should be of maximum 2 minutes
- Topics: current trending news/issues, social aspects REC
- Language: Hindi or English
- Team members: maximum of two
- PTC should have an opening, bridge, and a closing
- Words: no words should be used that include vulgar or tawdry substance.
- Awards: for first and second position cash prize/trophy and certificate
- For the third position trophy and certificate only.
- Participation certificates for all participants.
- Results: will be declared during the event closing ceremony

- The video must be shot inside the IMS UC campus
- Video must not exceed the time limit of 1 minute
- The video must be related to the given topic. (the topic will be given at the time of competition)
- Every individual should make their own video.
- The video may include voiceover and music. Both must be decent.
- Can include pictures related to the given topic (the pictures must be shot inside the IMS UC campus)
- Avoid the use of abusive language or content.
- Video must be submitted in a 16:9 ratio (landscape) format.
- Your video should be engaging to the audience.
- You can also include your face in the video, make sure you present yourself as confident in front of the camera.
- The video can be shot through phones/cameras
- The video is to be submitted in the stipulated time frame with video editing.

- Digital manipulation that distorts the reality of the image will not be allowed.
- The Submission deadline is 2nd March 2024, before 2 pm.
- All submitted images are non-returnable. The file name for each image should be clearly labeled with the participant's name.
- Participants are entirely responsible for all entryrelated costs.
- All participants can submit their photographs by hand or by registered post after the online registration.
   Once the hard copy is submitted, your participation will be confirmed.

## 4. Media Rangoli

- The theme of the competition is restricted to "Power of Media".
- Only colors and flowers can be used for making rangoli.
- Material for making Rangoli to be brought by the participants.
- The Rangoli should be drawn in the space fixed by the judges. It will be the same for every team for all the participants.
- Each team may have a maximum of four participants from the same institution.
- A fixed time limit will be allocated to the participants to draw the Rangoli.
- No pencils or chalk are allowed to make rough sketches as it has to be traditional.
- The use of stencils is prohibited.
- During Rangoli making, students are not allowed to carry any kind of paper materials or electronic gadgets.
- The space provided will be of measurement 4 feet by 4 feet. Participants have to complete their artwork within the given space
- The time duration allotted will be 1 and a half hours.
   No extra time will be given in any case.
- Decisions taken by the judges will be final and shall be accepted by all.

#### 5. Solo Act

- Only solo participation is allowed
- The theme of the performances sh Bollywood.
- Use of abusive and vulgar language is prohibited
- Performance that hurts anyone's sentiments, offensive to any person or community is allowed.
- Judging criteria include adherence to the theme, voice, character, plot, dialogues, stagecraft, and overall impression.
- Costumes should be selected accordingly.
- Performance Time limit: 2 5 minutes
- If any props are to be used, the information of it is to be given before the performance.
   Additionally, effects that may create clutter on the stage (fire, water, or powdered colors) are prohibited.
